## **PREFACE**

Kings Engineering College facilitates aspiring students in pursuing higher education by minimizing their financial constraints and supporting them in availing scholarships from various Government and Non-Government organizations. Established in 2001, Kings Engineering College is a Christian Minority Self-Financing institution approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi, and affiliated with Anna University, Chennai. The institution is managed by the Chartian Educational and Health Trust, a registered public trust for educational and charitable purposes, under the aegis of the Rajam Group of Companies, Chennai.

The college encourages and supports students from economically weaker sections and those with outstanding academic performance by providing scholarships, fee concessions, and financial assistance through various schemes offered by Government agencies and private organizations. These initiatives ensure that no deserving and meritorious student is deprived of continuing his or her academic career due to financial limitations.

In addition to Government scholarship schemes available to eligible students, the institution also extends financial support through management scholarships and fee concessions to deserving candidates admitted to the college. Special consideration is given to students who demonstrate exemplary academic excellence, leadership qualities, sports achievements, and other talents.

Furthermore, the institution provides additional support facilities such as free ships for books, transport concessions, and other student welfare measures based on genuine needs and requests. These scholarships and concessions are intended not only to support students financially but also to motivate them to excel academically and actively participate in co-curricular and extracurricular activities throughout their course of study.

This policy encompasses the various scholarship schemes and financial assistance initiatives made available to financially deprived and deserving students studying at the institution. It serves as a guiding framework for the college in facilitating students to avail appropriate scholarships and financial support based on their eligibility under different criteria.

## **SCHOLARSHIP POLICY**

### **PREAMBLE**

Kings Engineering College is committed to providing quality education to deserving students from all sections of society. The institution strongly believes that financial constraints should not become a barrier to higher education. To promote academic excellence, social equity, inclusiveness, and support for economically weaker sections, the college implements various scholarship schemes offered by the Government, Management, and other agencies.

The Scholarship Policy aims to:

- Encourage meritorious students to pursue higher education.
- Support economically disadvantaged students.
- Promote inclusive education for rural and underprivileged communities.
- Increase access to technical education among first-generation learners.
- Motivate students to achieve academic excellence and continuity in education.

The institution facilitates scholarships through Government schemes, institutional support, and special welfare initiatives.

### **OBJECTIVES OF THE SCHOLARSHIP POLICY**

The objectives of the scholarship policy are:

- To provide financial assistance to deserving students.
- To encourage students from rural and economically weaker backgrounds.
- To support students belonging to SC / ST / BC / MBC / DNC communities.
- To motivate girl students to continue higher education.
- To reduce dropout rates due to financial difficulties.
- To recognize academic merit and social commitment.
- To ensure equal educational opportunities for all students.

### **1. INSTITUTIONAL SCHOLARSHIP POLICY**

Kings Engineering College believes that quality education should be accessible to students from all economic and social backgrounds. As part of its institutional social responsibility, the college has introduced a special scholarship policy to support deserving and underprivileged students. Under this policy, 25 students from the constitutional locality of the Director are offered 100% free education every academic year. The scholarship includes a complete waiver of both tuition fees and hostel fees. This initiative is intended to uplift economically weaker students and provide them with opportunities to pursue higher education without financial burden. The selection of students is made based on economic condition, academic interest, and recommendations approved by the management. Through this policy, the institution demonstrates its commitment towards social welfare, educational equality, and rural student empowerment.

### **2. 7.5% GOVERNMENT SCHOOL STUDENTS RESERVATION SCHEME**

The Government of Tamil Nadu introduced the 7.5% reservation scheme to encourage students from Government Schools to pursue professional education, including engineering courses. This scheme is applicable to students who have studied from 6th to 12th standard entirely in Government Schools and secured admission through counseling. Eligible students receive various financial benefits such as tuition fee reimbursement, hostel fee support, and coverage of certain academic expenses as prescribed by Government norms. Kings Engineering College actively supports students in availing this benefit by assisting them in document verification, scholarship application procedures, and follow-up processes. The scheme plays a vital role in bridging educational inequality and increasing higher education opportunities for rural and first-generation learners.

### **3. PRIME MINISTER'S SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME (PMSS)**

The Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSS) is implemented to provide financial support to deserving students pursuing higher education. The scheme aims to

encourage students from economically weaker sections and help them continue their academic journey without financial hardship. Students who satisfy the eligibility criteria prescribed by the Government can apply through the National Scholarship Portal (NSP). The scholarship generally covers tuition fees, maintenance allowances, and other educational assistance as notified by the authorities. Kings Engineering College provides continuous support to students during registration, document submission, online application, and renewal procedures. The institution ensures that eligible students receive proper guidance and assistance to successfully avail the scholarship benefits.

#### **4. PUDHUMAI PEN THITTAM SCHOLARSHIP**

The Pudhumai Pen Thittam is a flagship welfare initiative introduced by the Government of Tamil Nadu to encourage girl students to pursue higher education. Under this scheme, girl students who studied from 6th to 12th standard in Government Schools and continue their education in recognized higher educational institutions are eligible to receive monthly financial assistance as prescribed by the Government. The objective of the scheme is to promote women empowerment, reduce dropout rates among female students, and improve the participation of girls in higher education. Kings Engineering College actively facilitates awareness, registration, and scholarship processing for eligible students. The institution encourages girl students to utilize this opportunity to achieve academic and professional success.

#### **5. COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP**

Community Scholarships are provided by the Government to support students belonging to socially and economically disadvantaged communities such as SC, ST, BC, MBC, and DNC categories. The scholarship aims to ensure educational equality and provide financial assistance to students pursuing higher education. Eligible students may receive tuition fee reimbursement, examination fee concession, maintenance allowance, and hostel fee support as per Government norms. To avail the scholarship, students are required to submit valid community certificates, income certificates, academic records, and other supporting documents. Kings Engineering College extends full assistance to students in completing the scholarship application and verification procedures. This scholarship scheme significantly contributes to the educational advancement of marginalized communities and promotes inclusive growth in society.

#### **6. TAMIL PUDHALVAN SCHOLARSHIP**

The Tamil Pudhalvan Scholarship Scheme has been introduced by the Government of Tamil Nadu to support male students from Government Schools in pursuing higher education. The scheme provides financial assistance to eligible students who continue their studies in recognized institutions after completing schooling in Government Schools. The primary objective of the scheme is to encourage rural and economically weaker male students to continue professional and technical education without financial constraints. ## **7. PRADHAN MANTRI KAUSHAL VIKAS YOJANA (PMKVY)**
